

SUMMER STUDENTSHIP NOTICE F4E-ST-2014

'Fusion for Energy' (F4E) proposes **summer studentships** for periods of **2 to 3 months**. The summer studentship program aims at promoting awareness, knowledge and understanding of 'Fusion for Energy's role in the ITER project and within the European context, as well as to provide short-period training to university students.

These traineeships give students an opportunity to put their learning into practice, gain an insight into the F4E's activities and operations, and to contribute to the F4E's mission. The tasks performed by trainees are supervised and depend on the Unit/Project Team they join. It can consist of research tasks, the preparation of draft reports, the compilation of statistical data, the execution of operational tasks and the participation in ad hoc studies.

REQUIREMENTS

The traineeship is open to applicants who have not previously undertaken a traineeship in F4E.

In order to be eligible to a summer studentship, applicants must fulfil the following requirements before the closing date for the submission of applications:

- Be a national of one of the 28 Member States of the European Union or of a Third state fully associated with the Euratom fusion programme (Switzerland);
- Be aged 18 to 25;
- Be following university studies;
- Have a good knowledge of at least two Community languages, one of which should be English, the main working language of F4E;
- Have a social behaviour and conduct compatible with F4E standards.

F4E reserves the right to amend the eligibility criteria as and when necessary. Any such changes will be published on the website before the start of the opening of the application period.

STARTING DATE AND DURATION

The duration of each summer studentship shall be 2 to 3 months, from 1 June to 30 September. The date of taking up duties shall be on 1 or 16th of every month.

The starting date of the studentship will be determined by F4E according to its needs, in agreement with the students.

ALLOWANCE

As referred in article 3 of the Rules governing the F4E Summer Studentships, students shall be awarded a monthly maintenance allowance. The monthly allowance for 2014 amounts to €1087,39.

Additionally, students may receive a travel allowance, subject to budget availability, to compensate for travel expenses incurred from the place of residence to the seat of F4E and vice versa.

THE EUROPEAN JOINT UNDERTAKING FOR ITER AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF FUSION ENERGY

The living allowance is transferred to the student's bank account monthly on the following dates, provided all the relevant documents have been submitted within the deadlines:

First month of the studentship: paid at the end of the month.

Following months: paid around 16th of each month.

Trainees are advised to make sure that they have sufficient funds to cover all the costs of the first month of the traineeship (first rental payment, deposits and guarantees, food and transport, etc).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Applicants must register their applications online through the F4E Studentship Application tool by creating a valid F4E user account, duly filling in all the requested mandatory fields marked with an asterisk and submitting the following 2 documents:

- A detailed Europass curriculum vitae in English (can be obtained at the following address: http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/en/documents/curriculum-vitae)
- A motivation letter of 2 pages maximum in English

Please note that the online application tool is the *only* acceptable means of sending in applications.

Applicants are responsible for keeping their e-mail addresses and personal details up to date in their profile in F4E online application tool.

Closing date: Applications can be submitted until

25/04/2014 at 12h00 noon, Barcelona GMT+1.

After the closing date and time for applications the database will no longer be accessible.

Applications that do not meet the requirements or are incorrectly submitted will be rejected.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to inform 'Fusion for Energy' about any technical problem without delay within the deadline mentioned above.

Please, do not send any supporting documents (i.e.: copies of your ID-card, educational certificates, evidence of previous professional experience etc.) with your application at this stage.

APPROXIMATE CALENDAR OF EVENTS

The evaluation of the applications and the selection of students will take place in the immediate period following the closing date for submission of applications, in line with the needs of 'Fusion for Energy'.

The final selection will take place during May.
