Evaluation Process & Contract Award:

Proposals will be evaluated by an impartial, professionally competent technical evaluation committee of the ITER Organisation. Consideration will be given to the suitability of the proposed Technical Proposal relative to the Specific Requirements detailed in the technical specification. A contract will be awarded on the basis of best value for money according to the following: Technical content will be scored out of a maximum of 100 points and weighed by 60%. The lowest priced offer will receive the maximum score (100) and be weighted by 40%. All other financial offers will be divided into the lowest priced offer in turn (next highest) to give a score inversely proportionate to the price offered. The offer with the best weighted score out of a maximum of 100 points will be deemed to represent the best value for money. No other criteria will be used.
